Completion of Nema Verification of damage and request form for :

- PLUMBING FIXTURES & MATERIALS
- HOUSEHOLD FURNITURE
- FURNISHINGS
- APPLIANCES
- GENERATORS

Individuals seeking to import goods under exigency order more than once must obtain approval prior from NEMA.



Customs Officer ranked no less than Superintendents will be responsible for approving the release of qualified goods at the border.



In all other instances and for the importation of Motor vehicles, NEMA approval will be required prior to the clearance and release of the goods.
